

Disneyland Trip Behavior Guidelines

In order for our trip to be a success, all must follow the following guidelines:

HOTEL BEHAVIOR

- Be considerate at all times! **Use a quiet voice when conversing in halls!**
- If a problem arises, call Mr. Perazzo, Mrs. Borris or a chaperone.
- **Running and loud talking in the hallways disturbs others.**
- Vote on a room leader to take care of the key.
- Valuables left in your room could be stolen. When away from the hotel, keep your valuables on the bus.
- **Never** leave your room without locking the door, and without your room key.
- Keep your rooms clean.
- **NO ONE** is to leave the hotel without a group!
- Boys are not allowed in girl's rooms and no girl's in boy's rooms. **No exception.**
- If someone knocks on your door check to see who it is before opening. Use security chain on door at night. **Only open for Chaperon with a badge.**
- When we depart, make sure that your room key gets to your chaperon.
- Adhere to the "in-room" and "lights-out" times. "Lights-out" means lights off and all in bed. **Do not leave room for any reason (i.e. ice or sodas).**
- Check the weather before leaving for the park. Take what you need for the day, as we will not be returning to the hotel until late night.

GROUP TOGETHERNESS

- **Buddy System:** Your personal safety is a priority. It is **required** that you have a buddy with you at all times during your trip. **NO ONE IS TO GO OFF ALONE**
- **Punctuality:** It is important to be on time so that the rest of the group does not have to wait for you. Tardy individuals may be asked to spend the rest of the trip with an adult
- Get your rest and be kind to everyone. We will be together 24 hours-a-day... learn to give and take.

GENERAL

- **NO** weapons, fireworks or snap rocks/poppers.
- **NO** alcohol or drugs of any type.
- Strangers are to remain strangers - do not pick up.
- Do not leave any of your possessions out of sight. You are responsible for them. If you leave something somewhere, we won't go back for it.
- Be responsible! Look out for one another so that we may have a great trip.
- Students will be given **ID badges** that they are to wear and have visible at all times in Disneyland. Lost badges can be replaced at a cost of ten dollars. **Students without ID will have to remain with an adult.**
- **NO CELL PHONES** are allowed to be out at any meeting, check-in time, or when moving from park to park, or to the busses. Students not adhering to this policy will lose free time. **We need you to pay attention to all instructions. Your safety is our number one priority.**
- **Please turn off your child's Access to the internet.** Students need only the ability to make phone calls and text.

DISCIPLINE

1. Three strikes and you're out policy.

2. Some infractions can count automatically as three strikes (*i.e. causing harm or injury to anyone, illegal drug/alcohol use, etc.*)

3. At night during room checks (*in room, and lights out*), chaperones will knock on door the first time, the second time, Mr. Perazzo, or Mr. Parsons will deal with you.
